Dr. Rev. Daniel Jastram	Stationed in Tokyo, Japan. "Nourishing the Faithful" he is the only LCMS missionary in the entire country of Japan. He speaks Japanese fluently.	
Jacob and Jacy Franzen	YWAM (Youth With a Mission), stationed in Colorado. YWAM's purpose is to "know God and to make Him known". Jacy is training teams of youth how to share the Gospel, internationally. Jacob is overseeing the Discipleship Training School (DTS) program.	
Jonathan and Carrie Federwitz	Jonathan is training pilots for the mission field through "Jungle Aviation and Radio Services" (JAARS) in Waxhaw, NC. His training of pilots makes the work of Bible Translators possible. Carrie is administrative assistant, logging and filing records for all flight training.	
Nathan and Sarah Federwitz	Nathan is the son of Jonathan Federwitz and is a missionary pilot in Papua New Guinea.
